

Beginning Japanese Drawing list for Portfolio

Draw:

- 1A yourself
- 1B a picture of you, your family, and pets
- 2A a friend and their family
- 3A your school and your school schedule
- 3B your school club/sport/music, or what else you have after school
- 4A you and your friends or family members with indicators for your heritage, where your family roots are from, countries people you know are from and languages spoken by the people in your drawing
- 4B things you do and don't do/eat/drink, etc.
- 5A a calendar for the month. Include kanji for days of the week on top and label at least 10 things you will do during the month in Japanese or with pictures.
- 5B a timeline of your life. Include the year you were born, the year you entered elementary school, and middle school as well as at least 5 other events in your life. Do not write words for these things, but draw small pictures to represent the events.
- 6A you and five friends. Show exaggerated physical features and types of clothing/glasses/jewelry, etc. that they might wear.
- 6B yourself, decked out with the best clothes, jewelry, and accessories you'd like to wear.
- 7A you and two friends or family members and you hobbies.
- 7B you and two friends or family members and foods, drinks, and activities you each like, dislike, love, and hate.
- 8A a picture of three separate days of a vacation. The first drawing is what happened yesterday, the middle is what you are doing today, and then tomorrow is what happens tomorrow. Include things you saw/see/will see, and things you did/and will do in the others.
- 8B a picture of you with two thought bubbles depicting things you remember that you will be able to describe with at least four adjectives each and two with things you hope to experience that you will be able to describe with the same number of adjectives.
- 9A a picture of a shopping excursion you've won at the mall. Draw a picture of the places you'll shop and the items along with prices that you'll pay for them. You can spend up to \$10,000 on your venture, but you have only 2 hours to shop. Include images for all of the things you'll be talking about.
- 9B a picture of a gift-giving party you remember. Include presents that were given and received by people at the party as well as other things that were around.
- 10A a weather report for a week. Include a variety of possible weather events on your chart.
- 10B a picture of an event you and others are going to. The event should be at one end of the page, your house at the other, and you and the people you are going with in the middle in the vehicle that you take.
